

## HALLOWEEN CRAWL RULES 2025

- 1. NO ALCOHOL!
- 2. Speed limit is 15mph on gravel roads.
- 3. Drivers must be at least 18 years old.
- 4. There are no bathrooms once you leave the Registration Area be prepared.
- 5. Please use nice language this is a family friendly event.
- 6. First rig out by 8:00am. Last rig needs to start by 9:30am.
- 7. Final Check-in 4:00pm. Our goal is to start the awards and raffle by 4:30pm.
- 8. Checkpoints
  - Maps will be handed out at each checkpoint.
  - Halloween items will be hidden along the paths. Note them on your map(s) as you travel and show them at the checkpoints to received bonus points.
  - At the checkpoint, you will complete at least one activity. Most will be done from your vehicle. Passengers may also have activities.
  - Before you leave the checkpoint, you will be given a map to the next checkpoint.
  - Stop at all checkpoints and complete all task(s).
  - Final Checkpoint is back at Registration.
- 9. To ensure things keep moving
  - Do NOT stop in the middle of the trail to take a break. Find a spot to pull off. There
    will be two checkpoints where there will be room to park.
  - Allow faster groups to "wheel" through.
  - When attempting an obstacle or finding yourself stuck, please make two attempts. If at that point you are not successful, hook up and/or back out.
- 10. IF you need to leave the event early, please notify the Registration Table so we can account for you and know you're safe.
- 11. Failure to comply with the rules in whole or in part will result in disqualification from the event.
- 12. In case of emergency or if you need assistance, all volunteers will have radios on GMRS Channel 16.
- 13. Please pick up trash along the route. This keeps the trails open for future wheeling!
