



Trail Leader-Driver Meeting-Quick List

- Tow Points – Front and Rear – Know Where yours are!**
- CB/GMRS Radio – Channel**
- Winch – Use Safe Winching Practices**
- Stop at intersections: Wait to be sure rig behind sees you turn**
- Leave Room: Between you and the next rig, in front and behind**
- Both Driver and Passenger: Keep arms and other body parts INSIDE the rig**
- Wear your Seat Belts**
- Tread Lightly: If not, you will be educated**
- Practice Trail Etiquette: If not, you will be educated**
- Explain Hand signals to oncoming rigs indicating # of Rigs Behind**
- Spotters: Ask for a spotter if desired. Choose 1 Spotter to listen to!**
- If you have trouble or get stuck, Let someone know**
- If you need to leave early, let the Trail Leader know (we count periodically to make sure we don't leave someone.**
- “Stuff Happens”: Understand, Scratches & body Damage is Possible**
- If you have Questions, Ask now**
- Driver Experience – Begin, Intermediate, Experienced**
- Rig Capability – Tires, Lift, Body Armor**



Trail Leader Responsibilities

- Choose meeting time and place for run**
- Hold a Drivers Meeting, use the driver meeting quick list**
- Roll Call: Take Drivers names of Members and Guests**
- Take note of how many rigs begin, end and periodically, to be sure you don't lose anyone**
- Place People without winches or radios, between those who do**
- Make sure YOUR Radio works**
- Choose a tail gunner to bring up the rear of the group**
- Make sure Tail gunner radio works**
- Remind people to wait for the rig behind them...often**
- If you come across someone parked on the trail, stop and ask if they are OK, and let them know how many are in your group**
